<b>Less than &lt;5 ug/dL</b>	Follow Screening Guidelines: <u>Always test at 12 AND 24 months of age.</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Evaluate nutrition and risk of lead exposure</li> <li>Provide anticipatory guidance to caregiver on lead poisoning, test results, lead hazards and prevention <i>*(nutrition, housekeeping, hand washing, controlling hand-to mouth behavior, avoiding take-home lead)</i></li> </ul>	<b>NO</b>	<b>NOT required</b>
<b>5 - 9 ug/dL</b>	<b><u>VENOUS CONFIRMATORY</u></b> <b><u>within 3 months</u></b>  Retest every 6 months until <5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>History and physical</li> <li>Evaluate nutrition and lead exposure history</li> <li>Provide guidance to caregiver on lead poisoning, test results, lead hazards and prevention and importance of retesting</li> <li>WIC referral</li> </ul>	<b>YES</b>  <b>800-346-6520</b>	<b>NOT required</b>
<b>10-14 ug/dL</b>	<b><u>VENOUS CONFIRMATORY</u></b>  <b><u>within 3 months</u></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>History and physical</li> <li>Evaluate nutrition and lead exposure history</li> <li>Provide guidance to caregiver on lead poisoning, test results, lead hazards and prevention and importance of retesting</li> <li>WIC referral and consider Hgb/Hct</li> </ul>	<b>YES</b>  <b>800-346-6520</b>	<b>YES – <u>2 results</u> in this range.</b>
<b>15-19 ug/dL</b>	<b><u>VENOUS CONFIRMATORY</u></b>  <b><u>within to 1 month.</u></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>History and physical</li> <li>Evaluate nutrition, psychosocial and neurodevelopmental status and lead exposure history</li> <li>Provide guidance to caregiver on lead poisoning, test results, lead hazards and prevention and importance of retesting</li> <li>Hgb/Hct and WIC referral</li> </ul>	<b>YES</b>  <b>800-346-6520</b>	<b>YES</b> <b><u>Two venous results 30 days apart</u></b>
<b>20-44 ug/dL</b>	<b><u>VENOUS CONFIRMATORY</u></b>  Retest every 1 weeks to 1 month.	Same as Above <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Treat any Iron Deficiency</b></li> <li><b>Order Bowl Decontamination if indicated</b></li> <li><b>Refer to CCS</b></li> </ul>	<b>YES</b> <b><u>urgent referral</u></b> <b>800-346-6520</b>	<b>YES</b> <b><u>One venous result</u> in this range</b>
<b>45 ug/dL and Above</b>	<b><u>VENOUS CONFIRMATORY</u></b>  If 45-59: within 48 hours If 60 and above: 24 hours Over 70: immediately  Retest every 2 weeks to 1 month.	<b>Urgent Medical Situation</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Consider</b> hospitalization to prevent further exposure, implement treatment , and monitor response</li> <li><b>Consider Chelation, and x-rays and bowel decontamination</b></li> <li><b>If using BAL for chelation at this level, be aware of potential for peanut allergy reaction.</b></li> <li><b>Refer family members (especially if pregnant) for evaluation and testing; test all children in family</b></li> <li><b>Immediately notify local Riverside County CLPPP at 951.358-5481</b></li> </ul>	<b>YES</b> <b><u>Immediate referral</u></b> <b>800-346-6520</b>	<b>YES</b> <b><u>One venous result</u> in this range</b>
